Water in the storm drain system receives no treatment or filtering process and is completely separate from the City's sewer system. Runoff drains from the street into the gutter, and enters the system through an opening in the curb called a catch basin. Catch basins serve as the neighborhood entry point for the journey into the ocean. Pollutants can harm fish and wildlife populations and make recreational areas unsafe and unpleasant.
